

# **2018 Advanced Placement (AP) Test for Faculty of Science, National University of Singapore**

## **Important Announcement:**

Existing NUSHS students who have read and passed NUS regular modules under the Non-Graduating Non-Exchange (NGNE) scheme at NUS are not allowed to sit for the AP Test(s) for these module(s).

## **Eligibility:**

Existing NUSHS students who have obtained excellent overall results and done very well in the relevant subjects at NUSHS will be eligible. Each NUSHS student will only be allowed to opt for a maximum of 5 modules (i.e. 20 modular credits) for AP Test.

## **Test Syllabus and Other Critical Information:**

Existing NUSHS students are to refer to the Faculty of Science AP Test website from March 2018 onwards for the test syllabus and updates on the AP Test for AY2018/2019.

## **Format and Standard of AP Test Paper:**

The format and the standard of the test are identical to the current examination format adopted for NUS undergraduates taking the module during NUS regular semesters.

## **Grading Basis:**

Under the existing NUS framework for Advanced Placement Credits (APCs), ex-NUSHS students who have taken and passed the AP Test(s) prior to admission to NUS will be able to receive APCs and be awarded the modular credits with no Letter Grades if they register as undergraduates with the Faculty of Science.

## **Administrative Fees:**

A non-refundable administrative fee of S\$50 will be charged for the AP Test of each module.

## **Timeline:**

Application closes on **31 May 2018**.

AP Tests will be held from **22 June 2018 – 29 June 2018**.

Test results will be released to students by **middle of July 2018**.
