Hub of All Things (HAT)

Prof Irene C L NG (Physics 1986) created HAT in 2013, a world pioneering innovation enabling individuals to own their data in a "HAT Microserver". HAT has since spun out as a non-profit foundation and a commercial startup - Dataswift - which recently received £1.8 million in seed funding. Prof Ng built businesses in four countries and is now both the Chief Executive Officer of Dataswift and a Professor at University of Warwick. She also runs Innovorsa, a family office that incubates and invests in new startups.
